9. Any other business

Andrew said that he had met with a parent following the circulation of the Accessibility questionnaire. As a result he had two suggestions for suitable hearing loops for the school. There is an individual loop that would be most suitable for classroom environments. This system involves the teacher wearing a microphone. The cost is approximately £400. It was agreed that this could be ordered as and when the need arose but there is currently no requirement in school at present. There is also a hearing loop that is portable and would be suitable for use in the school halls, office and other areas. The cost is approximately £1,000. It was agreed that this system would be ordered and would be made available for school productions etc.

Action Judith to arrange purchase

Sue said that the new Freedom of Information Act has highlighted the need for a school statement regarding significant donations to the school, this would include donations made to the school by the MSA (Milton School Association – parent teacher association). Gary asked if there were model statements available and suggested it would be useful to see what other schools have done.
