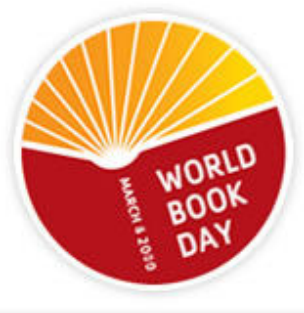
### School Dinner Money

**Please can I remind you that payment for school meals should be made in advance.** The preferred method of payment is by cheque which should be made payable to Milton CE Primary School. Money should be put in an envelope and clearly marked with the child's name, class and the amount enclosed. **Payment should be received on a Monday or the first day of the half term for those parents would prefer to pay with one cheque.** Cost of the school meals up to Easter is £56.00.

Each Monday and Friday office staff dedicate a large proportion of their time to dealing with money for school meals. Currently we are receiving a lot of dinner money on other days, this has to be recorded separately which is proving time consuming and is impacting on other work that needs to be undertaken by the office staff. We would be grateful for your cooperation in this matter. Thank you.

### Promotion Lunches

Please can we ask parents to inform school that their child wishes to have a promotional lunch by the date requested. Yesterday 40 additional children expected the pancake lunch who had not requested it. The catering staff have to order meals in advance so need accurate numbers. In future we will not be in the position to accept requests after the given deadline. Children will always be fed but they would not receive a promotional meal.
